

**CITY OF DANIA BEACH
DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY ORDER
(September 2nd, 2021)**

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, a State of Emergency was declared in the City of Dania Beach by Mayor Lori Lewellen relating to the Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (“COVID-19”), and there have been a series of Emergency orders from the State of Florida, Broward County and the City of Dania Beach; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has issued Emergency Orders 21-101 and 21-102, limiting local government authority as to restrictions or mandates upon businesses or individuals due to the COVID-19 emergency; and

WHEREAS, the City, in compliance with the Governor’s orders is not extending emergency orders relating to businesses or individuals in the COVID-19 emergency but is recognizing that there remains a valid health emergency due to COVID-19;

BY ORDER OF THE MAYOR under her emergency powers and authority:

Section 1. Effective Date. The above whereas clauses are incorporated by reference into this Emergency Order (“EO”). The City’s emergency declaration of emergency applies as to City procurement. The EO of May 6th, 2021, May 13th, 2021, May 20,2021, May 27, 2021, June 3, 2021, June 10, 2021, June 17th, 2021, June 24, 2021, July 1st, 2021 and July 8, 2021, July 15, 2021, July 22, 2021, July 29, 2021, August 5, 2021, August 12, 2021, August 19, 2021 and August 26, 2021 are incorporated by reference, however any provision of any of those EO’s in conflict with this EO are superseded.

Therefore, the Emergency Orders except as applied to individuals and businesses when inconsistent with the referenced Governor Orders, are incorporated into this Order and extended from 12:00 a.m. on September 3, 2021, for seven (7) days, as related to City procurement actions.
